The applicant further agrees that neither Inter-Community Celebration Association, the Borough of Berlin, nor Berlin Township nor any public or private property owner, whose property is utilized for the event, shall be liable for any damage arising directly or indirectly from any act or omission of event sponsors or any customer at the event and does hereby agree to waive any and all claims or causes of action for damages, losses or expenses against Inter-Community Celebration Association, the Borough of Berlin, Berlin Township, its agents, public officials, officers, employees and authorized volunteers.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the applicant shall indemnify, keep and save harmless Inter-Community Celebration Association, the Borough of Berlin, Berlin Township, New Jersey and its agents, officers, and employees and any other public or private property owner whose property is utilized for the event, against all injuries, death, losses, damages, claims, suits, liabilities, judgements, cost and expenses which arise directly for any negligence or reckless or willful misconduct of the applicant, its participants, employees or agents. The applicant shall pay all of its own expenses, appear, defend and pay all charges of attorney and all cost and other expenses arising there from or incurred in connection therewith. If any judgment shall be rendered against Inter-Community Celebration Association, the Borough of Berlin, Berlin Township or another property owner in such action, the applicant shall, at its own expense, satisfy and discharge the same.
